

# Advanced Placement French



- **Course Description:**  
AP French is built on a four-part basis: reading, writing, speaking and listening. An AP exam is offered toward the end the course in May. AP offers a variety of authentic French materials and is mostly taught in the target language.
- **Course Expectations:**  
Students are expected to complete a 300 page workbook outside of class and write a minimum of 8 compositions in French. No other homework would typically be assigned.
- **Special Projects:**  
A unit on French filmography will be presented at the end of the course. Students will be able to develop an idea based on a chosen genre.
- **Beyond the general education course:**  
Students must be self-motivated and very proactive.
- **Other:**  
Students will generally perform very well if all work is completed. Testing is rare and is usually in the form of a quiz.
