## WHO MAY APPLY?

To apply for a nomination, you must be a

- U.S. Citizen
- Between the ages of 17 and 23, applicants for the Merchant Marine Academy may be as old as 25
- Unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation for the support of a dependant.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply, you will need to provide Congressman Reichert's office the information listed below as apply directly with the service academy or academies of interest:

- A completed application form. Forms may be obtained by contacting Jacques Imperial in the District Office.
- A sealed copy of your high school transcript.
- Three letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation may not come from family members and at least one letter must

be from a teacher, principal, or high school counselor.

- SAT (4161) or ACT (7745) scores sent directly from the testing agency.
- Resume – please list activities, employment service, honors, awards and accomplishments. Please also include a statement of personal interests and experiences.
- Essay – Your essay should address why you should be nominated to a service academy. Please keep the essay to 2 pages, use 12 point font and double space.
- Photo of yourself.
